 - a. As December 31, 2015, the current year expenditure is \$1,604,619 of the total \$2,600,000 award. The HUD receivable amount is \$738,237. As of February 29th 2016, the HUD receivable is \$452,259 of which \$429,212 pertains to the December 2015 HUD reimbursement voucher, which is in the process of submission. Currently there is a difference of \$23,046 which would have to be reconciled. The difference might be due to a voucher submitted but not yet reimbursed.
