A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FIRE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE GRANTS FOR TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS ACT, S. 4654

- WHEREAS, the United Native American Housing Association (UNAHA) is comprised of thirty-four individual member Indian Housing Authorities, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Tribes from the states of Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and Utah, and
- WHEREAS, the Senate has introduced a proposed bill S. 4654 entitled the "Fire Management Assistance Grants for Tribal Governments Act"; and
- WHEREAS, loss of housing units by fire and other natural disasters is a constant threat to the resident occupants and affordable housing units owned and managed by UNAHA member TDHEs; and
- WHEREAS, tribes have not previously been able to directly access fire and other disaster planning and recovery funds at the federal level; and
- WHEREAS, UNAHA member TDHEs will and should be significant contributors to disaster planning, prevention, and recovery efforts in their communities; and
- WHEREAS, allowing tribes to directly access federal fire management assistance will directly benefit TDHE residents and the TDHEs' ability to protect families and affordable housing units in their communities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that UNAHA urges Congress to approve and pass the Fire Management Assistance Grants for Tribal Governments Act, S. 4654, in calendar year 2024;
