RESOLUTION #2025-01**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RE-AUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT

WHEREAS, the United Native American Housing Association (UNAHA) is comprised of thirty-four individual member Indian Housing Authorities, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Tribes from the states of Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and Utah, and

WHEREAS, both the House and Senate have proposed bills for the re-authorization of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) and hope to reintroduce those bills in the current 2025 session; and


WHEREAS, the bills, contain important amendments and improvements to NAHASDA that will benefit the tribes administering the block grants; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in Indian Country when it passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that UNAHA urges Congress to approve and pass the reauthorization of NAHASDA in calendar year 2025.
