A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RE-AUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT

- WHEREAS, the United Native American Housing Association (UNAHA) is comprised of thirty-four individual member Indian Housing Authorities, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Tribes from the states of Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and Utah, and
- WHEREAS, both the House and Senate have proposed bills for the re-authorization of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) and hope to reintroduce those bills in the current 2025 session; and
- WHEREAS, the bills, contain important amendments and improvements to NAHASDA that will benefit the tribes administering the block grants; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in Indian Country when it passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that UNAHA urges Congress to approve and pass the reauthorization of NAHASDA in calendar year 2025.
