RESOLUTION #2025-02**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING INCREASED FUNDING FOR INDIAN AND
ALASKA NATIVE HOUSING**

WHEREAS, the United Native American Housing Association (UNAHA) is comprised of thirty-four individual member Indian Housing Authorities, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Tribes from the states of Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and Utah, and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in Indian Country when it passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended; and


WHEREAS, in 2024 and again in 2025 Congress provided \$1.3 billion in funding for Indian and Alaska Native housing programs including for the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act (NAHASDA) and the Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG); and

WHEREAS, \$1.3 billion is a base level of funding that accounts in part for 25 years of inflation that was not accounted for in previous appropriations.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that UNAHA urges Congress to appropriate more than \$1.3 billion for Indian and Native Alaska housing programs for FY2026.
