RESOLUTION #2025-04**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TRIBAL TRUST LAND
HOMEOWNERSHIP ACT (S. 723 & H.R. 2130)**

WHEREAS, the United Native American Housing Association (UNAHA) is comprised of thirty-four individual member Indian Housing Authorities, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Tribes from the states of Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and Utah, and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in Indian Country when it passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Trust Land Homeownership Act (S. 723 & H.R. 2130) includes provisions that would support, improve, and preserve important affordable housing in Indian Trust land areas; and


WHEREAS, UNAHA member tribally designated housing entities would benefit from these much-needed reforms of the management of trust land resources.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that UNAHA urges Congress to pass the Tribal Trust Land Homeownership Act (S. 723 & H.R. 2130).
